FYI, I sent out the following to relatives this morning.

I have a melanoma on my scalp, at the top, it has been visible for some time and felt like a hard boney matter, but only recently have I gone to the dermatologist to find out about its nature.

Situation probably traces back to my ENT doctor several years ago when I was having balance problems. Sometimes these are related to the inner ear. After extensive tests, they concluded that the problem must be in the brain, not the inner ear, either a stroke or a tumor. Neither was good, so I declined the recommended scan of the head; turns out they were exactly right, it was must have been a tumor. This is running in parallel with the prostate cancer so these results are not surprising.

My decision here traces back to Jesus' parable (Lk 14:24-33), "Count the Cost" when choosing your battles. I am not aware of anyone who has truly defeated cancer, it is a living state and therefore you must negotiate with it. That is what I have done, with my casodex pill, (\$10 a month prescription) which held it at bay for the last five + years.

Life is good, just sometimes more challenging than at another times.
